 Help us each to take one hand in our hand

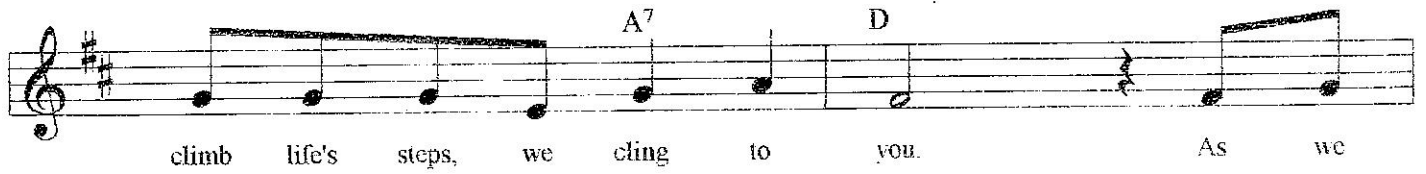

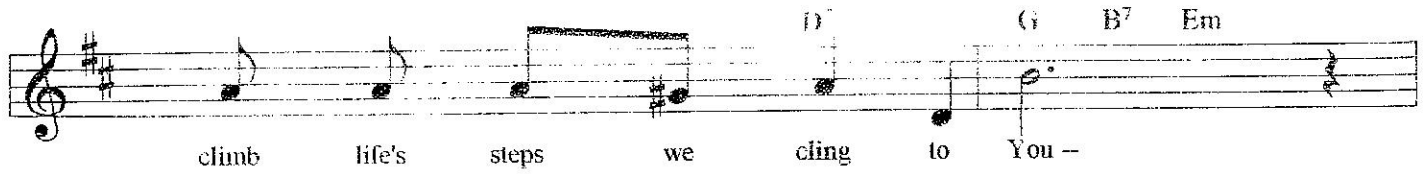
